- Thank God for a successful meeting between CFCM staff and the principal of EBCoM, and the opportunity to run training on four afternoons during the college term, to equip students in skills for children's ministry. The seminars did not take place this month but will hopefully take place soon.
- Thank God for the refreshed partnership with Zambesi Mission in Malawi, with whom CFCM staff will meet during the second week of every month for prayer for the ministry.
- Thank God that despite the busyness of school programmes, Chitakale primary school recognises the importance of CFCM's regular Bible clubs and has allocated 12 noon on Thursdays for the club there to continue.
- Thank God for all the CFCM volunteers who also have established good relationships with schools in their communities and who are regularly running Bible clubs for the school children during term times.

PETITIONS

- Pray for Esnat, the young disabled girl supported by CFCM. She has been ill for some months and has not been able to go to school. Pray that she get the care and medical attention that she needs so that she will recover, and so that her education and presence at the CFCM Bible club will resume.
- This month there will be CFCM seminars held at Usisya (13th - 14th) run by Samson Ngakapalika and Pastor Tembo, Chiradzulu (13th – 14th) run by Elevate Mizinga and Joseph Jeke, and Phalombe (27th – 28th) run by Paul Gazeni and Michael Namalenga. All of these venues received Level 1 training last year, and this month the plan is to complete Levels 2 and 3. Pray that all the teachers who received Level 1 will return to complete the course. Pray that they will be motivated to establish Bible clubs in their communities as well as the children's ministry they conduct in their churches.
