THANKSGIVING

- Praise God that Esnart, the disabled girl from Chitakale, is now much better. Pray that she will be able to return to school and Bible club.
- Praise God for last month's CFCM seminars held in Usisya, Chiradzulu and Phalombe. These were return visits to carry out Modules 2 and 3 over two days. A total of 54 Sunday school teachers successfully completed the assessment and received certificates. Praise God that they are now able to explain the Gospel in ways that children can understand. Pray that the children in their Sunday schools and Bible clubs will come to faith in Christ Jesus. Thank God that the seminars in Phalombe and Chiradzulu went ahead despite heavy rain during that weekend.
- These seminars also included demonstration Bible clubs. The teachers were really appreciative of the opportunity to see how to organise a Bible club, to have practical experience and to learn from seeing their trainers in action. Pray that this will be a great motivator and help in the establishment of new Bible clubs in these locations.

PETITIONS

- Pray that God will bless five separate 5-day clubs going on from 6th – 10th April in Rumphi (with teachers Karen and Beatrice), Mangochi (Esther), Phalombe (Gazeni, Namalenga, Gomani), Pensulo (Elevate, Joseph, Frank, Mai Sanga, Abusa Canache) and Mulunguzi (Elevate, Joseph, Frank, Abusa Canache, EBCoM students). The theme at all the clubs will be "Turned Around", with Bible stories about Zaccheus, Mephibosheth, Noah, Ethiopian treasurer and Saul.
- Pray for stamina for everyone involved, especially the two Blantyre clubs organised by office staff, when they will be in Pensulo every morning and Mulunguzi every afternoon.
- At Pensulo and Mulunguzi, Joseph will be telling the missionary story about an Indian boy who lived in fear of the evil spirits but came to know the power of God in his life. Pray that the children will really relate to this story, and that God will use it to help them turn their lives around.
- In the Central Region, trainings will be taking place at Dedza (trainers Oden, Esther) and Dowa (trainers Simeon, Mai Manda). Pray for good numbers to attend.
