#### THANKSGIVING

- Praise God for the five CFCM 5-day clubs from 6<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> April in Rumphu (with teachers Karen and Beatrice), Mangochi (Esther), Phalombe (Gazeni, Namalenga, Gomani), Pensulo (Elevate, Joseph, Frank, Mai Sanga, Abusa Canache) and Mulunguzi (Elevate, Joseph, Frank, Abusa Canache). By day 5, there were over 800 children in attendance across all the Bible clubs, and many of them responded by giving their lives to the Lord.
- Thank God for the local teachers and church members who assisted the teams. Thank God for the ongoing work of the Bible clubs in these places, praying that the event will result in increased numbers and enthusiasm among the children for learning the Word of God.
- Praise God for last month's seminars. 16 teachers from 9 different churches completed level 2 & 3 training at Dowa, and 22 teachers from 10 different churches did the same at Dedza. Thank God for the tireless work of CFCM volunteer trainers Simeon and Mrs Manda (Dowa) and Oden and Esther (Dedza).
- Thank God that CFCM's trustees met last month, and for their renewed commitment to support the ministry.
- Thank God for the support of Zambesi Mission. Last month Elevate and Joseph attended a meeting in Blantyre of all ZM partners and were greatly encouraged to be able to share and pray together.
- Thank God that Elevate and Joseph have been able to benefit from Growing Young Disciples online academy this year with other international students.

#### PETITIONS

- Pray for the children who committed their lives to the Lord at the Easter 5-Day clubs, that they will continue to be nurtured and disciplined at local churches and their commitment will be life-long.
- Pray for this month's seminars at Mwanza rural (May 22-23, run by the staff team) and Rumphu (May 15-16, run by Pastor Tembo and Blessings).
- The availability and the cost of fuel in Malawi (now the highest in the whole of Africa) is becoming a large problem for anyone doing ministry in the country. Pray that the fuel crisis in Malawi will not hamper CFCM's work, and for wisdom to adapt the programme as needed.
- The increase in petrol prices will have a knock-on effect to the price of food and all commodities. Pray for all CFCM staff and volunteers as they struggle with the cost of living.
