- Praise God for all the teachers who attended CFCM teacher training seminars last month. 2-day seminars were held at Golomoti, Biliwiri and on Likoma Island. Thank God for safe travel to and from the venues, and for the 58 Sunday school teachers who are now fully trained, assessed, and have received their certificates. Pray that they will be faithful to the Word of God as they minister to children in their churches and communities.
- Thank God that the teachers at Golomoti also benefited from training in making compost, thanks to Zambesi Mission.
- Thank God for all the trainers who were involved in these seminars, especially the volunteers and those who had to travel some distance.
- Thank God for the opportunity given to CFCM's Elevate Mizinga to share in the children's ministry at her church's (Zambezi Evangelical Church) Revival Conference held at Mitsidi on the last weekend of August. Elevate worked alongside other ZEC Sunday school teachers and the Coordinator for Children's Ministry throughout the 3-day programme.
- The same weekend, CFCM's Joseph Jeke ran a similar children's programme during his church's (Christ's Ambassadors) conference in Chiradzulu. He was assisted by CFCM's volunteer, Mr Yamikani. Thank God for the faithful proclamation of the Gospel to so many children.
- Praise God that these two events reached 300-400 children and may lead to a new CFCM Bible club at Chiradzulu.

- Pray for the CFCM office staff as they prepare for December's residential camp – a first for CFCM - for a group of children in Blantyre. Pray as staff consider all the safeguarding issues and adjust their policies accordingly. Pray over decisions about the programme and the choice of venue.
